

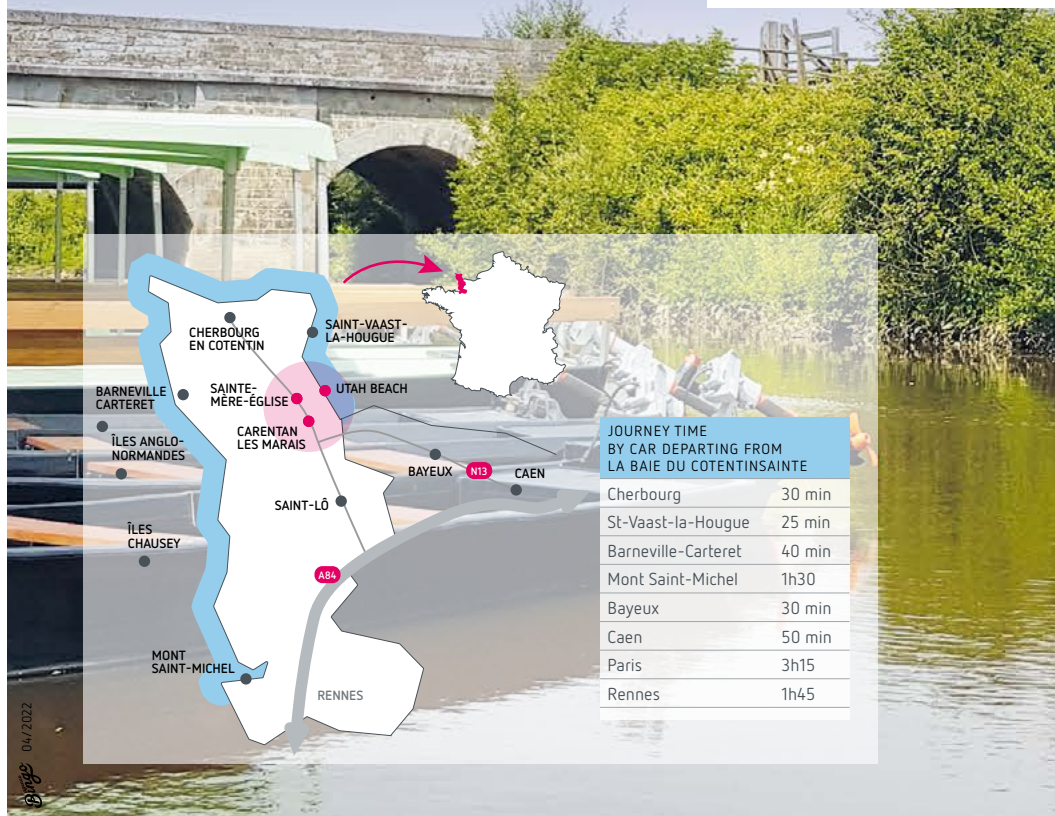

Sainte-Mère-Église



This peaceful commune saw its history shaped during the night of 5 and 6 June 1944, when American paratroopers from the 82nd Airborne Division liberated the village.

In 1962, the release of the film, "The Longest Day" in cinemas actively contributed to the village's fame. Today,

John Steele's parachute is still suspended from the tower of the church, while "borne 0" (kilometre 0), the Airborne Museum, the stained glass windows in the Notre-Dame de la Paix church, and the Paratrooper Memorial at la Fière are an emotional testament to the historic facts that led to the liberation of Europe.

Carentan les Marais

At the gateway to Cotentin, this shopping town has retained its medieval heritage, which can be explored by following the “A pied dans l’histoire” (history on foot) trail. (see page 28)

In 1944, as a strategic crossing point in the Baie des Veys, Carentan had to be liberated as quickly as possible by the American allies of the 101st Airborne Division, in order to sure up the junction between Utah Beach and Omaha Beach. After six days of fierce fighting, as retold in an episode in the series *Band of Brothers*, the town was finally liberated on 12 June by Lieutenant-Colonel Cole. Various monuments and sites can be visited, such as the D-Day Experience, the Normandy Victory Museum and the Manoir de Donville, which bear witness to this period of history.

The only D-Day beach

in the Channel, Utah Beach saw the landing of no less than 23,250 men, 1,700 combat vehicles and 1,695 tonnes of equipment as part of Operation Overlord launched by the Allies on 6 June 1944. Don't miss the Musée du Débarquement (Landing Museum) and the many monuments on the esplanade. Departing from the marina, the boat "Belle de Carentan" offers moving trips to see the beach from the sea, as the American soldiers would have experienced it.

Saint-Martin-de-Varreville



On the beach of Saint-Martin-de-Varreville, 3 km from Utah Beach, the monument pays homage to the 2nd Armoured Division of Général Leclerc, who landed here on 1st August 1944. The Leclerc division liberated Paris on 25 August 1944, then Strasbourg on 23 November 1944 and completed its victorious campaign in Berchtesgaden, Hitler's "Eagle's nest" in Bavaria.

D-Day Experience



Don't just learn about history, experience it!

A **realistic immersive and emotional visit** to understand the D-Day airborne landing. Two museums to explore: **the Dead Man's Corner** for the German troops and **the D-Day Experience** for the American troops.

Take a seat in a cabin on British soil for a **gripping 3-D briefing** then climb on board a **flight simulator in a real C-47**: an attraction that is one of its kind worldwide, regularly praised by veterans for its realism. You will relive the Channel crossing as a paratrooper.

A room equipped with a giant screen will help you discover the different stages of the Normandy Landings. Various authentic items from the collection, such as leather jackets with graffiti by soldiers to illustrate their exploits, are used to retell the story of Operation Overlord and that of each of their owners.

Within this museum complex, the large Paratrooper shop presents authentic items and many other souvenirs connected to the Normandy Landings.

Experience the Battle of the Hedgerows like you have never done before

You are invited to a **journey to the heart of history** with around 20 hyper-realistic recreations with sound, which recount the daily lives of civilians and soldiers during the 100 days that followed the Normandy landings. A focus is given to the Battle of the Hedgerows, a major Event in the Battle of Normandy.

In the 2,000m² of exhibition space, **10,000 authentic objects** are presented, including military and everyday items, vehicles and also several rare pieces, which you can see as part of the scenes. There is an exhibition highlighting the **role of women in the war**, and throughout the visit, you will see moving portraits of veterans (photos, videos, written testimonials) collected by Florent Plana during his travels.

Through spectacular museography that will be mostly renewed by the end of 2021, the Airborne Museum will allow you to experience the D-Day landings alongside the American paratroopers. Discover an **exceptional collection of historical objects**, **climb aboard an authentic glider** and **discover a C-47 aircraft that participated in the D-Day operations**.

You will board a real C-47 aircraft at night to experience the parachute drops of 6 June 1944, landing on the square in Sainte-Mère-Église in the middle of the fighting for freedom.

Thanks to **augmented reality**, the interactivity and hyper realist graphics on the tactile Histopad tablet, you will be transported into the heart of Normandy in 1944 and experience the highlights of the D-Day landings, witnessing the landing of the gliders and the setting up of a field hospital.

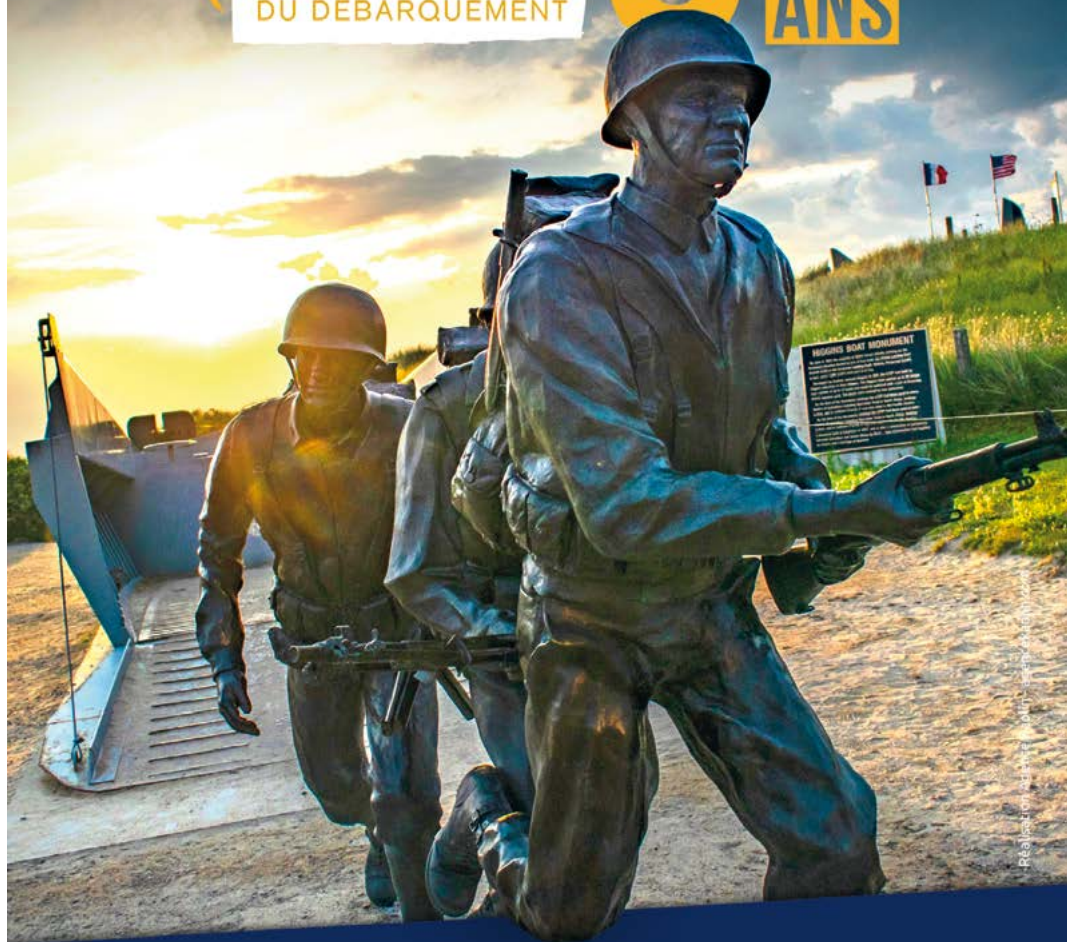

The Grande Casemate (blockhaus) de Crisbecq

Blown up in August 1944, the Grande Casemate de Crisbecq remained abandoned for 77 years before being reopened to the public in 2021. It is the last one that is still standing and the inside is accessible.

This bunker of impressive dimensions was one of the largest blockhouses of the Atlantic Wall in Normandy, with walls and a roof 3.50 metres thick, designed to house a 210mm gun with a range of 33km. Symbolic of the fighting during the capture of the German battery at Crisbecq by the 4th American Division, this historical site is now a memorial to the American soldiers who fell at Crisbecq between 7 and 12 June 1944.

Batterie de Crisbecq



A key D-Day landing site, where the first cannon shot was fired at dawn on 6 June 1944! Discover this exceptional and unmissable site by visiting the **22 underground blockhouses built at the time** by the most powerful artillery battery on the landing beaches. On a vast 5-hectare site, in a surprising complex of trenches and tunnels, plunge yourself into the atmosphere of a village with a garrison of 400 soldiers, in the heart of the Normandy battlefields. **The place where everything started.**

Discover this **site, one of a kind in the world**, with Historic Monument classification. Built by the French National Marines during the First World War, to house airships used against German submarines, the French Marines then used it to house **artillery batteries until 1939**. In June 1944, after heavy fighting by the 4th American Division,

the Americans set up maintenance workshops there for the vehicles and weapons, using prisoners as workers.

The tour takes place in three stages: **the museum** including contemporary equipment, models and videos, then **the Montebourg battle field and a visit to the hangar with its graffiti**.

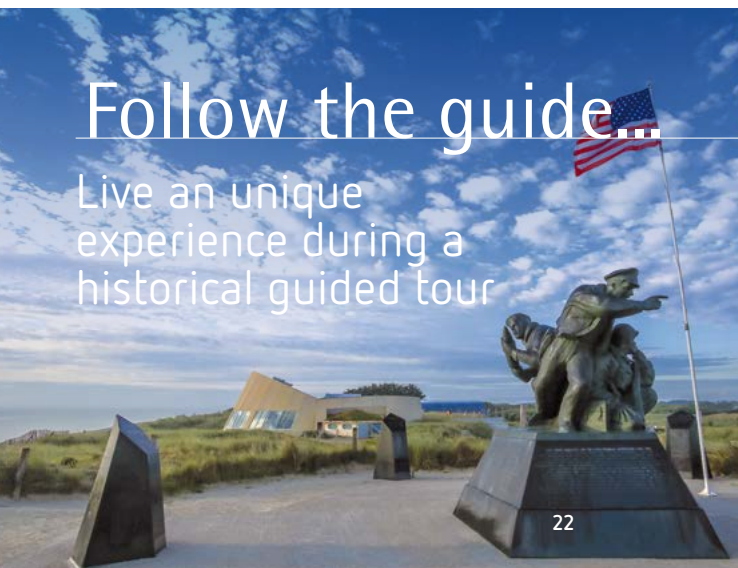

The marina

The port, with European Blue Flag status, has been welcoming yachtsmen since 1983, having been **a large commercial port in the 19th and 20th centuries**. A path along the banks offers a pleasant walk around the marina, passing the canal bridge and locks, which open onto **the magnificent and unspoilt Baie des Veys**.

A 20th century design, this structure is **unique in France** allowing the the RN13 to become a four-lane road under the dock between the marina and the sea. **This unique configuration means you can see a boat sailing above the cars!**

THE BRIÈRE HARDWARE STORE



During the First World War, Gaston Brière helped his sister whose husband had perished on the front. She ran a hardware store on the site of the Hôtel des Deux Billards, a shop that was destroyed by a fire. In 1918, Gaston Brière bought two shops, a café and a bicycle dealership, on the Place de la République and he had them knocked down to rebuild the hardware store that all the people of Carentan know today. In the early 1970s, after the death of their parents, the two daughters, Janine and Monique, took over the shop. Today, you can still find different cookery products with their authentic design: for cooking, preparation, cutlery, glassware, fireplace accessories and tableware.

Where can I see the marshes?

In the heart of the Cotentin and Bessin Marshes Regional Natural Park

To understand the landscape that surrounds you, interpretation boards have been installed on high points with an unobstructed view over the marshes, at the Pointe de Brévands, at the Marais du Rivage at Auvers, at the Marais de la Sèves and the peat bog in Baupré, in the hamlet of Longuerac in Moitiers-en-Bauptois, at the start of the discovery trail "Paysages à travers les âges" (Landscapes through the ages) at Place Général de Gaulle in Picauville and at the church in Liesville-sur-Douve.



The Marais des Ponts d'Ouve, a sensitive natural area

Through the Maison du Parc, you can access a series of wetlands (meadows, reedbeds, ditches, ponds and lakes) that are an ideal place for birds throughout the year. Discovery trails of between 2 to 6 km, depending on the season, will take you to the heart of the marshes where there are facilities for bird watching. In the winter, it's free!

MONTMARTIN-EN-GRAIGNES

A former lock house, dating from 1839, at the confluence of the Taute and the Vire-Taute canal, a witness of the history of river navigation, accessible by boat, but also on foot or by bike, thanks to the towpath.

NATIONAL NATURE RESERVE

Located between the land and the sea, in the commune of Sainte Marie du Mont, Domaine de Beauguillot nature reserve is a great spot for exploring nature. Located in the heart of the Baie des Veys, the domain belongs to the vast complex of marshes of the Cotentin isthmus. With a surface area of 500 hectares, the reserve is recognised as being of international importance as a stopover and wintering site for waterfowl. La Barquette lock is located on the Douve at Saint-Côme-du-Mont and regulates the water level of the Douve and Merderet valleys. It's a bridge-lock, put into service in 1735, equipped with nine floodgates, five of which are classified as Historic Monuments. Its gates close at high tide with the force of the of the tidal bore and open at ebb tide.

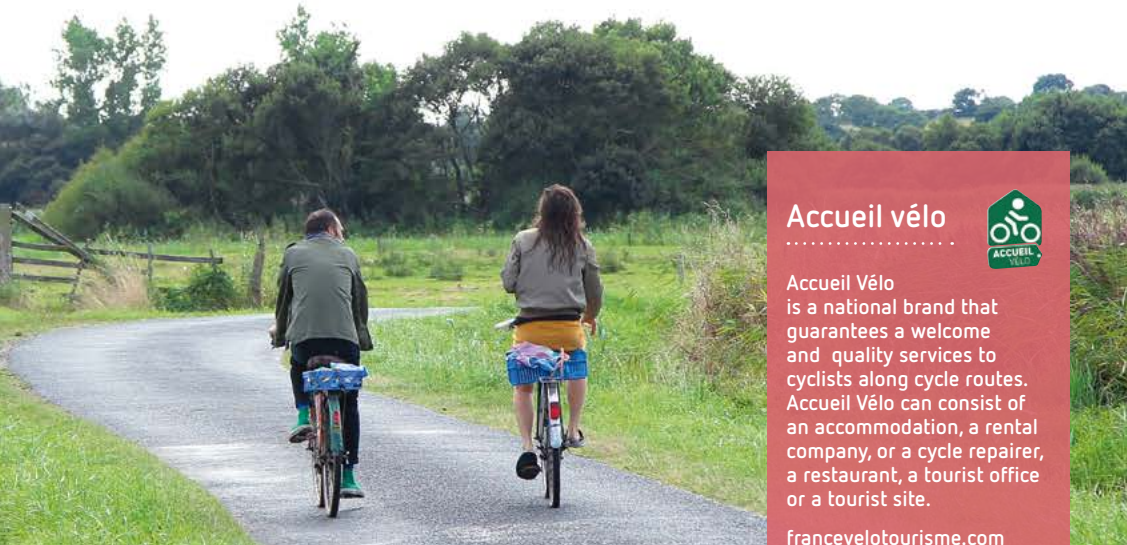

The EuroVelo 4, with a length of 4,000 km, connects Roscoff in France to Kyiv in Ukraine, crossing five countries: Belgium, Netherlands, Germany, the Czech Republic and Poland. In France, the Vélo Maritime® (the French part of the Euro Vélo 4 route) departs from Brittany, follows the Channel coast, then the Hauts-de-Seine to reach Belgium over 1,400 km, crossing iconic sites such as the Mont-Saint-Michel, the D-Day beaches, the cliffs of Etretat, the Baie de Somme and the Côte d'Opale.

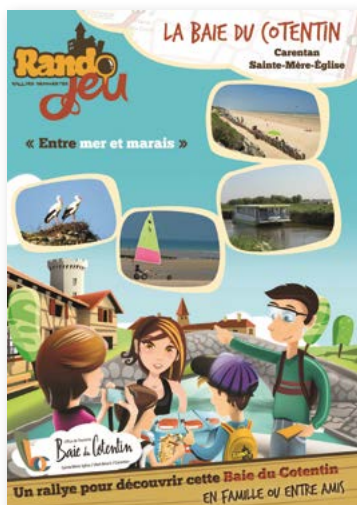

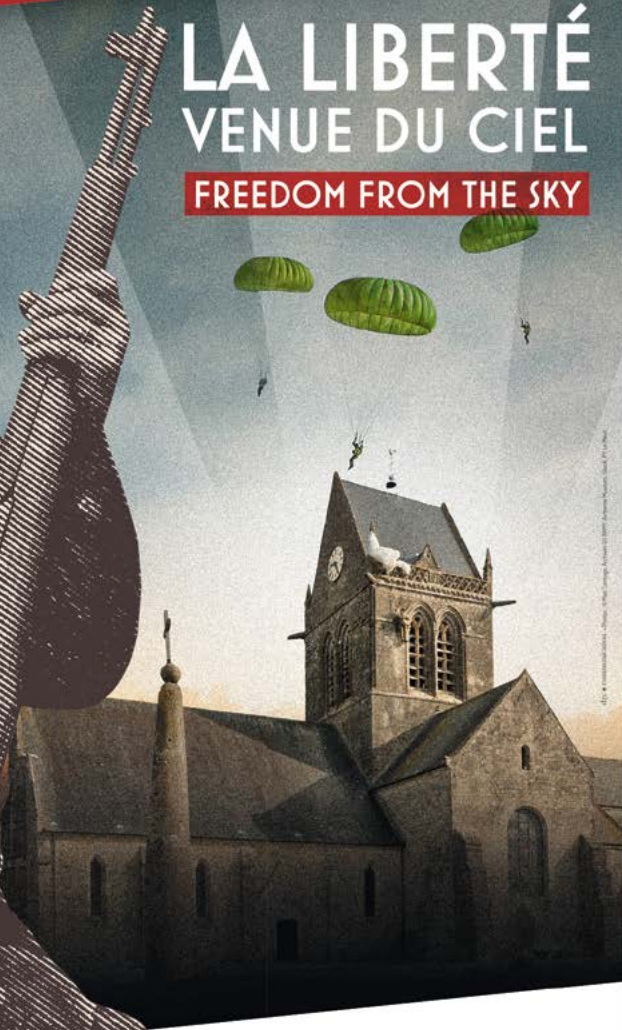
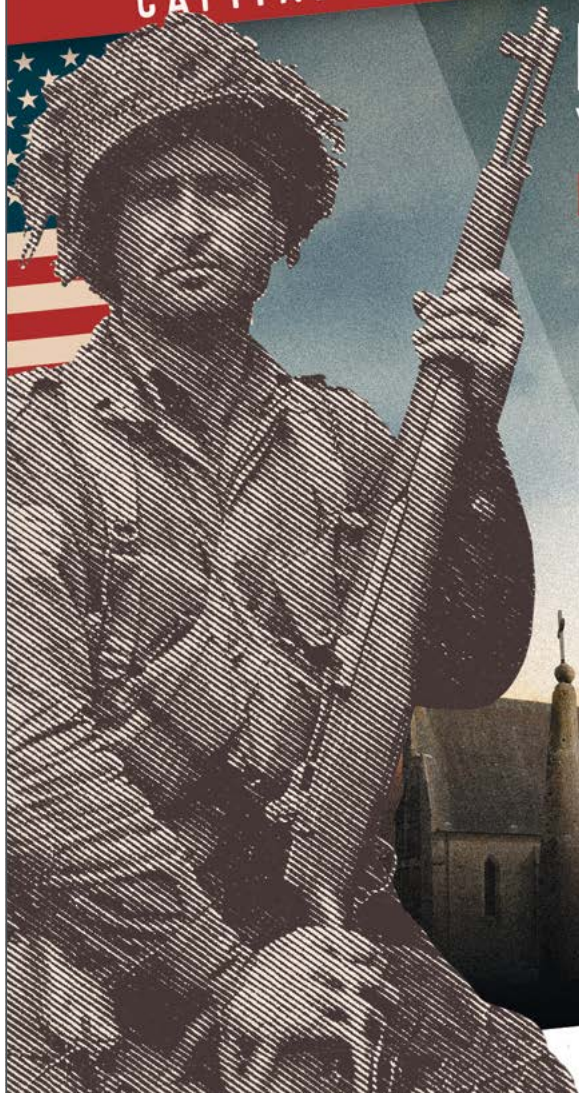
